Vow for Consistent Prayer and Worship

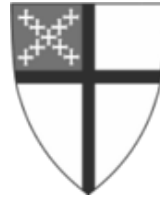

Through **worship and the sacraments** – Holy Eucharist, Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation, Holy Matrimony, Ministration to the Sick and Holy Orders -- we strengthen our faith and our relationship with God and with each other.

We also strive to bring hope and share God's love and peace to those who are in need through **Prince of Peace's Outreach Ministries**. These include:

In addition, we seek to bring peace of mind and heart to our neighbors through smaller, one time efforts such as collections of school supplies, clothing and other items for those experiencing sudden need.

Knowing that shared relationships helps foster peace and concord, our **Parish Life Events Team** seeks opportunities to promote fellowship and bring people together in fun ways. Some of our ongoing events include the Step Into Spring Fashion Show, monthly giant community yard sales held from May through October, an annual rummage sale and the Theme Tea Luncheon. These events are complimented by the projects coordinated by the Episcopal Church Women.

Children are an important focus for our parish family and in addition to a Church School program that emphasizes take-home faith lessons to enhance Sunday instruction, **Prince of Peace's children** have their own social calendar, including service projects, liturgical involvement, Easter Egg Hunt, Family Stations of the Cross, Family Autumn Outing and Breakfast With Santa Claus.

Adult faith formation opportunities are also offered, including seasonal enrichment forums, faith and film sharing opportunities and both individual and group Bible Study.

And supporting all these events and efforts is an underlying spirit of stewardship and encouragement for all to share their time, talent and treasure through **ministry opportunities** such as:
